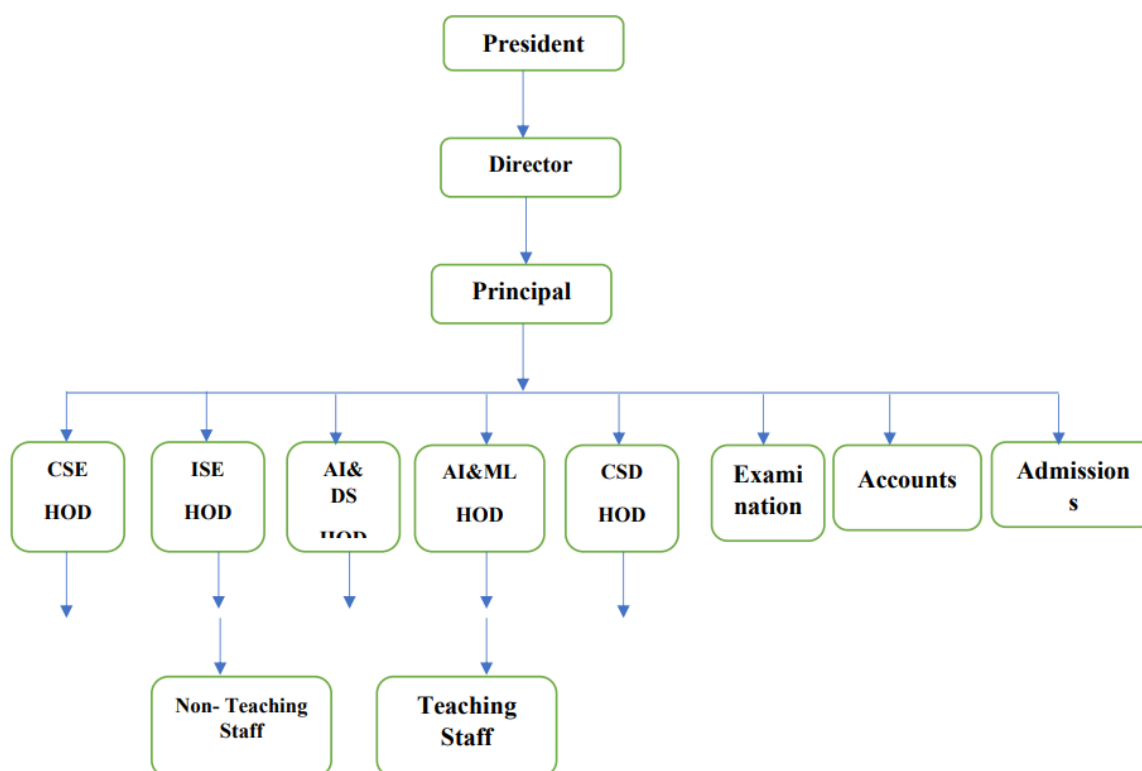

- No inmate is allowed to disturb other students by staying in others room after 8 pm.
- Inmates should not arrange any function or meeting or gathering within hostel
- Inmates are responsible for proper use of building furniture and other accessories. Any loss or damage to the hostel property should be borne by the inmates
- Students should not stick any posters/papers or write on the walls of the hostel.
- Hostel management does not own any responsibility for the loss of property left in the rooms unlocked or due to inmates negligence

“Plant more Trees, Save Water, Save Electricity, Avoid Plastics, The world is in your Hands”

- Inmates are strictly forbidden from using personal gadgets like immersion heaters, hot plates, etc. However appliances like personal computers are given permission on specific request
- Inmates should always keep their belongings under lock & key and also lock their rooms whenever they go out.
- Furniture and other items should not be moved out of the room.
- Wilful damage to furniture, electrical and other fittings will be recovered at the double cost from the individuals if identified otherwise recovered collectively from the inmates of that room.
- Inmates are not permitted to keep firecrackers/explosives or dangerous weapons or instruments that can cause serious injury to others.
- Smoking, consuming or possessing alcoholic drinks, gambling etc are strictly prohibited in the hostel.
- Private collection of funds must not be made under any circumstances.
- Inmates of the hostel are not allowed to make any complaint as a body or submit any group representation. However individual representations addressed to the warden alone will be looked into.
- No one shall indulge in politics, violence, rioting or instigate communal feelings or have dealings with outside organizations inside the premises. Such activities are prohibited and if found they are expelled from the hostel.
- The warden has full power to take any action or give punishments in the form of fine suspension or expulsion.
- Strict discipline should be maintained in the dining and common places in the hostel.
- Inmates securing less than 80% of class attendance in a semester/year are not permitted to stay in the hostel.
- Misconduct or violating the rules & regulations or involving in activities that are not befitting to the institution or bring down the reputation of the institution will make the inmate liable for severe disciplinary action and even amount to expulsion from the hostel.
- Apart from the above any other rule enforced by the Principal/Warden from time to time should be strictly followed by the inmates

Hostel Facility

- The hostels are provided with all basic facilities including water purifier, **washing machines**, and Wi-Fi.
- Concision will be given in mess bill in case the student has taken long leave due to medical issue.

Proctoring/Student Counsellor Details

During the four years journey of transformation through the B.E programme, students often need mentoring/ proctoring, guidance, and counselling from someone with whom they can share their woes. Any academic issues, career options or fear of a subject need great involvement of the proctor. This system exists in our institution, BGSCET, Mahalakshimpuram , Bengaluru, to improve the academic quality upgradation in line with NBA guidelines. The students will be much benefited by this continuous expert guidance and will be helpful in tracking the alumni in future. Procedure: Each faculty will be a

mentor for a group of at most 21 students. Every section is equipped with three proctors. First year students will have proctors from the department of Computer Science Engineering and its allied branches & Applied Science. The second, third and fourth year students will have proctors from their parent department. Departmental faculties will continue to be mentors for the same group of students till the completion of their graduation.

Responsibilities: The proctor will perform the following functions and will always do more for the benefit of the students.

1. Meet the group of students at least twice a month.
2. Continuously monitor, counsel, guide and motivate the students in all academic matters.
3. Advise students regarding upgrading and upskilling themselves.
4. Discuss with students regarding self-employment opportunities, entrepreneurship development, morale, honesty and integrity required for career growth.
5. Contact parents/guardians if situation demands regarding academic irregularities, negative behavioural changes and interpersonal relations, detrimental activities etc. after discussion with chief proctor and principal.
6. Advise students in their career development/professional guidance.
7. Intimate the chief proctor and suggest if any administrative action is called for.
8. Maintain a detail progressive record of the student (format attached).
9. Maintain a brief and clear record of all the discussions happening with students.

Chief Proctor:

1. Meet all the proctors at least once a month to review proper implementation of the system.
2. Advise proctors wherever necessary.
3. Initiate administrative action on a student whenever necessary, after discussion with principal.
4. Keep the head of the institute(principal) informed about the minutes of meeting. Every proctor is supposed to maintain personal details of the students including their address, contact numbers, overall academic performance and progress which will help in monitoring the academic growth and development in transformation of each student. To advise the students regarding choice of electives, projects, summer training, etc. To guide the students in taking up extra academic and professional activities for value addition as a member of the society


